sign up children in the target area. In addition 62 children have been signed up through the Scotia Air National Guard.

-Cinderella Project- The event will take place on March 31 at Siena College. "Shopping" will occur during two shifts: 10:30-12:30 and 12:30-2:30. Dress drives will take place over the summer. The project is in need of accessories for next year including purses, jewelry, makeup, perfume, etc.
